DISCIPLINE

- 7(I) Students should take their seats before the lecturer enters the class room and should not ordinarily leave their seats during a lecturer. Late comers may be allowed to enter the class room, but they can not claim attendance.
- ii) Students should not loiter on the corridors or the verandah. When they have no classes to attend, they may remain either in the Reading room or in their Common Room.
- iii) While a class is going on, students should not assemble at the door. Non-Collegiate are not allowed to attend the classes.
- v) Students must not spit on the walls, floor, doors of the college. They should not stand at odd places obstructing the free movement of others, Scribbling, pasting Placards or Posters or otherwise disfiguring college walls or boards are strictly prohibited.
- vi) The students must not temper not temper with the electrical fittings or mishandle Bi-cycle or two wheelers or other articles which do not to them.
- vii) Admission of a student can be cancelled at any time and compulsory college leaving certificates be issued if it is found that his or her conduct is not satisfactory and his or her behavior goes against the greater interest of the college.
- vii) No student is allowed to come to the college with mobile phone. If found with mobile Phone strict disciplinary action as deemed fit will be taken against them.
